



COVID-19 Preparedness and Responsiveness Plan

These rules apply to ALL attendees, including participants and staff:

- Social Distancing & Other Protective Measures:
 - **All attendees must comply with all recommended social distancing guidelines as outlined by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, the State of Michigan and Log Road.**
 - **NO SPECTATORS**, unless bringing a minor child. **No one will be allowed in spectator area.**
 - Temperatures of all attendees will be taken at the Front Gate.
 - All attendees must be free from COVID-19 symptoms for at least 14 days prior to attendance.
- No Camping
- No Concession services will be provided
- Personal Protective Equipment
 - All attendees must wear a face covering when at Front Gate or Registration.
- Parking/Pit Area
 - All vehicles must park at least 12 feet apart from each other.
 - All attendees must remain in their pit area, unless on their way to or from the track to ride.
 - Attendees may not have anyone in their pit area other than those with whom they arrived.
 - No sharing of food or beverage with anyone with whom attendee did not arrive.
 - Riders may not ride their motorcycle or quad, except to and from the track.
 - No pit bikes or bicycles of any type allowed.
 - Attendees will be responsible for collecting and removing all of their own trash from the property. Trash can be put in the dump trailer by the Front Gate.

RIDING INFORMATION

- Rider will be given an envelope at the Front Gate with a copy of the rules, waiver & ink pen. Rider must bring envelope down to registration to sign the waiver, pay gate fee and riding fee. Upon receipt of payment a riding wrist band will be issued.
- Registration
 - **Only the rider** will be permitted to attend registration.
 - The only exception is that 1 guardian must accompany a minor rider.
 - Riders must have exact change for each attendee. Gate Fee \$8.00/Riding Fee \$30.00
- Riding Procedures
 - Staging area will be marked off with banners or cones to adhere with the 6-foot guidelines.
 - Only the rider may be at the starting line. No pit crew or mechanic will be allowed.
 - The only exception is 1 guardian of a minor rider under 10.
 - While riding, all riders must maintain a 6-foot distance apart from all other riders.
 - This is a recreational ride. Riders shall not engage in close contact maneuvers.
- Entrance onto tracks
 - There will be no unauthorized people on the main track or 50 track at any time.
 - Guardians/parents may only enter the 50 track if their own minor child needs assistance.
- Entrance into Log Road Buildings
 - No one, other than staff, will be permitted to enter any structures on Log Road's property, including but not limited to Registration, Front Gate and Concession.
- Log Road Provided Wash Stations
 - Riders will not be allowed to use the wash stations to wash their bikes.
- If a rider goes down on the track and needs medical assistance, no one is permitted to enter the track. The rider will be brought to the ambulance and family can join the rider at the ambulance with a face mask on.

All attendees MUST abide by these rules.

If you do not, you WILL be asked to leave.
